The Association was \$1,156.00 over budget on Operating Expenses. The Income and Expense Comparative report was reviewed.

Manager's Report:

The 2021 Project List was reviewed.

The yearly Inclinometer readings were completed and the State Inspection.

The monthly Activity Report was reviewed.

The 2021 Reserve Projection spread sheet was reviewed.

It was learned that a resident submitted a Board nomination form through the website, but it was not received and thus, not included in the mailed notice.
